The Australasian Association of Engineering Education (AAEE) Winter School is an experience that brings together engineering education researchers.

Attendees will learn about:

- Designing and undertaking effective education research projects
- Evaluating teaching and curriculum
- Positioning evaluation and research activities in light of current trends
- Appreciating and responding to national and local grant opportunities
- Building collaborative research partnerships across Australia and beyond

This year we are trialling the online delivery of Winter School so rather than having 5 days on zoom we have staggered the sessions across the two weeks starting 12th July as indicated above.
